#### **CHAPTER II**

#### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

#### A. Hotel's Profile

## 1. Hotel's History

The Ritz-Carlton hotel history begins with a young man named Cesar Ritz, who was born in the mid-1800s. During twenty years of age, Cesar Ritz began working as an apprentice waiter in a hotel in Paris. Cesar managed to work from assistant waiter to head waiter than to manager with hard work, dedication, and a spirit of excellence. Then, Cesar met the famous French chef Auguste Escoffier, and they soon became business partners and friends.

When Cesar became the manager of the Hotel Savoy, a famous hotel in London, Cesar further developed the service philosophy. Cesar turned hotels into works of art where the guests were always the center of attention, the experience which is called The Ritz-Carlton Mystique. After many years, the opportunity came for Cesar to design a hotel. Cesar took Chef Escoffier and together, they turned a former prince's palace into the very first hotel bearing Cesar's name – The Ritz, Paris.

The Ritz opened in 1898 and redefined the luxury hotel experience in Europe. At the same time, Cesar was involved with developing the Carlton hotels in London. Eventually, the two names merged into future properties as The Ritz-Carlton. Cesar designed The Ritz-Carlton logo, which is a combination of the British royal seal (the crown) and the logo of a financial backer (the lion).

Beginning in 1910, with permission from Cesar Ritz, several Ritz-Carlton hotels were established in the U.S., but they were operating independently with different owner investors and not part of a single company. Then, in 1983, a group of hotel executives, including Horst Schulze and Herve Humler, working with an investor William B. Johnson had a dream to create a new luxury hotel company. They were very close to opening their first hotel in Buckhead, Atlanta to bear their company name "Monarch Hotels" when a new opportunity came, they could purchase the last remaining Ritz-Carlton hotel in Boston, Massachusetts, and with it, the exclusive rights to The Ritz-Carlton name, logo, and legacy. Finally, for the first time, The Ritz-Carlton hotels would be run by a single company with a common philosophy.

Private Pool



Ritz-Carlton, Bali Hotel is led by the General Manager who oversees the whole departments of the hotel. These departments also have their own head department for example: Room Division is led by Director of Rooms, Kitchen is led by the Executive Chef, Director of Food and Beverage leads food and Beverage Department, Engineering Department is led by Director of Engineering, Finance Department is led by Director of Finance.




Figure 2.15 Hotel's Organization Structure

### 2. In-Room Dining Organization Structure




Figure 2.16 In-Room Dining Organization Structure

### a. In-Room Dining Manager

In-Room Dining Manager duties and responsibilities are:

- 1) Managing items and staff in accordance to standards.
- 2) Ensuring IRD equipment and supplies are working and used properly.
- 3) Assisting IRD staff in daily working.
- 4) Attending leader's forum.
- 5) Establishing daily duty roster.
- 6) Ensuring daily operations are running accordingly.

### b. In-Room Dining Supervisor

In-Room Dining Supervisor duties and responsibilities are:

- 1) Assisting IRD staff in case the Manager is not present.
- 2) Attending leader's forum in case the Manager is not present.
- 3) Assisting Manager in overseeing daily operations.
- 4) Ensuring all equipment and supplies are working and used properly.
- 5) Reports to IRD Manager.

#### c. Order Taker

Order Taker duties and responsibilities are:

- 1) Taking care of guest orders.
- 2) Ensuring guest's orders and request are fulfilled.
- 3) Upselling hotel products.
- 4) Managing cashier.
- 5) Having good product knowledge.
- 6) Reports to IRD Manager and Supervisor.

#### d. Server

Server duties and responsibilities are:

- 1) Preparing all necessary items for daily operations.
- 2) Preparing guest's order and request.
- 3) Delivering guest's order and request.
- 4) Serving food and beverages to the guest according to the standard.
- 5) Cleaning and removing dirty plates from the guest's room.
- 6) Ensuring proper appearance and grooming.

#### e. Honor Bar Attendant

Honor Bar Attendant duties and responsibilities are:

- 1) Checking minibar in all the guest's room if there are any consumption.
- 2) Replenishing consumed items in the minibar.
- 3) Cleaning the minibar if necessary.
- 4) Maintain and track the expiry dates of the minibar products.
- 5) Reports to IRD Manager, Supervisor, and Order Taker.
