CHAPTER II

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

A. Hotel's Profile

1. History

Dormitory is one of the facilities provided by University Multimedia Nusantara for its students, especially those from outside Jabodetabek. The Dormitory Building was handed over from the Summarecon company to the Kompas company in 2009, and began to be inhabited by UMN students in 2011, The purpose of establishing the University Multimedia Nusantara dormitory is to form students who are independent, sensitive and foster a creative spirit.

This Dormitory is still held over by the Kompass Company and the University Multimedia Nusantara Dormitory is managed by Mrs. Evy Novita R, ST under the responsibility of Mr. Ir. Andre Andoko, M.Sc (Vice Rector II of UMN).

Each room is equipped with a spring bed, wardrobe, study table, study chair and full AC. UMN dormitory public facilities are equipped with a guest lobby, pantry on each floor equipped with a refrigerator, gas stove and microwave, an integrated security system, cleaning service, stationary, canteen, group study discussion room, parking for vehicles cars, motorbikes and bicycles.


