CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background

B. Purpose

C. Period and Procedures

1. Industrial Placement Program Period.

2. Procedures of Industrial Placement Program.

c. Admissions.

The students then given the schedule to visit Universitas Multimedia Nusantara to be given the knowledge about the housekeeping works to be done in the area, as well as to sign the contract stating that the individual had started the Industrial Placement Program at the dormitory.
