



ABSTRACT

Traditional ceremonies are a form of cultural heritage that aims to foster a group of people regarding the strengthening of norms and the preservation of cultural values. Javanese, as the largest ethnic group in Indonesia, has traditional ceremonies that revolve around the human life cycle (pregnancy, birth, death). Traditional food as a supporting element for traditional ceremonies has an important role. Traces of Indonesia's history are not recorded or documented in a complete or structured manner. 
