INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

Ninneez founded by Catherine McMaster, is a new and undeveloped business in Gold Coast Queensland of Australia that aims to revolutionise the medical garment industry into comfortable yet practical medical garments for individuals in aged care and addressing the specific needs of seniors with health issues. Catherine was inspired to start Ninneez after observing the constant discomfort faced by seniors especially women in aged care when undergoing mammograms.

The discomfort was mainly caused due to constant skin on skin friction like under the breast where bra is not usually worn and armpit resulting in skin issues and irritation. Resolving a constant oil treatment and powdering for the seniors that can be very agitated for them who also had to suffer from other health issues. Patients that are affected by stroke or have restriction in movement are shown to be struggling with dressing while the arms and shoulders movement are restricted. Driven by passion for alleviating this discomfort and improving the quality life for seniors in aged care, Catherine conceptualised the idea of medical garment that combines ease of use, accessibility, comfort, and functionality aiming to address the specific needs of seniors in aged care and hospital settings. Creating an adaptive medical garment that can reduce fractions with one of the designs having shoulder opening allow recumbent patients and ventilators without tangling lines to be dressed and have a very minimum amount of metal in the garment and allow for chest Xray to be taken without need for undressing the patients.

Currently, Ninneez is still in the process of finalising the product for medical garments and in process for the products to get patent on. Recognizing the importance of a solid business plan and the important role of the website in this era, Catherine reached out for assistance with Swinburne to develop a business plan so she can have a clear direction for Ninneez. Since Ninneez's website is currently developed by Catherine's relatives, she also would like to create a prototype website

to be compared with the Ninneez's.
