We have reached a decision regarding your submission to Informatica, "Deep Learning-Based Detection of AI-Generated Classical Music".

Our decision is to: Publish the paper.

If you haven't yet, prepare the camera-ready version following the author's guidelines at:

http://www.informatica.si/index.php/informatica/about/submissions#authorGuidelines, and resubmit the paper in a source format (Word doc or LaTeX) within one month. Please send your submission ID, payment information (name, surname, institution ...) for the invoice, and the selected publication type (ONLINE, IN-PRINT) to amsinformatica@ijs.si and drago.torkar@ijs.si.

We would like to inform you about the options regarding the publication times since at the moment there is a significant overload with accepted manuscripts. Informatica is in recent years publishing mainly on the Web with only a couple of printed copies, unlike in previous decades where the printed issues ranged from hundreds to one thousand copies. We still provide a couple of printed copies of the 4 issues per year, but now we are introducing additional issues without printed copies, meaning that the accepted manuscripts can be published immediately. The online-only issues will be recorded in all the same databases as the other 4 issues.

We would like you to reply to this e-mail with the chosen preference. If you want to be published in print as well, reply with the text IN-PRINT. This option, however, means that you may wait up to a year to be published since our in-print editions have a limited amount of space and the interest for being published in Informatica is considerable. You will get written confirmation of acceptance, though. If you want to be published online-only, reply with ONLINE-ONLY. This means that your manuscript will be published as soon as it is processed, meaning it will appear in Scopus indexing libraries much sooner. If both options are acceptable, reply with EITHER. If you do not reply to this e-mail, our editorial team will choose the option for your manuscript.
